

Biography – Timothy Riddiough

Timothy Riddiough is the E.J. Plesko Chair, Director of the Graaskamp Center for Real Estate, and Professor of Real Estate and Urban Land Economics at the University of Wisconsin–Madison. He is widely published, and one of the country’s foremost experts on credit risk issues in mortgage lending and securities markets. Tim also has research interests in financial intermediation, investment theory, option pricing, law and economy, and regulation—all as they apply to real estate issues. He is the past recipient of the American Real Estate and Urban Economics Association best dissertation and best paper awards, and is a fellow at the Homer Hoyt Institute for Advanced Studies and the Real Estate Research Institute. He has served on the boards of several organizations, including ArCap REIT, Inc., Equibase Capital Partners, Wrightwood Capital, LaSalle Investment Management, and the Massachusetts State College Building Authority. Tim was also a long-time managing editor of *Real Estate Finance*. Professor Riddiough earned his Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin–Madison in 1991 and was a tenured professor at MIT prior to returning to Madison in 2001.
